EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 130  
Series of 2021

**AN ORDER DECLARING BUKIDNON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS, BARANGAY 3, MALAYBALAY CITY UNDER LOCALIZED LOCKDOWN AND FOCUSED CONTAINMENT/COMMUNITY QUARANTINE TO PREVENT, CONTAIN AND MITIGATE THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 CONTAGION IN THE AREA**

- WHEREAS**, Sec. 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates Local Government Units to, among others, promote the health and safety of their constituents;
- WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte through Proclamation No. 922 s. 2020, declared a state of public health emergency due to the rapid proliferation of COVID-19 in the country;
- WHEREAS**, the City Government has consistently supported the programs of the national government in the fight against COVID-19 by closely collaborating with the concerned government agencies, the other local government units, including the barangays and the private sector in the adoption of appropriate programs and measures intended to prevent the possible local transmissions of the disease;
- WHEREAS**, five (5) confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 were identified as employees of Bukidnon National High School (BNHS) located in Barangay 3, Malaybalay City, namely, a 27-year-old female (CCN No. 316), a 33-year-old female (CCN No. 317), a 27-year-old male (CCN No. 318), and a 30-year-old female (CCN No. 319), a 29-year-old male (CCN No. 320);
- WHEREAS**, there is a need to lockdown Bukidnon National High School (BNHS) campus in order to immediately prevent, contain and mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 infection in the area;
- WHEREAS**, prior coordination with the Department of Health had already been sought for immediate technical assistance and guidance to appropriately manage the urgent situation in the locality;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, FLORENCIO T. FLORES, JR.**, Mayor of the City of Malaybalay, Province of Bukidnon, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:
- SECTION 1. LOCALIZED LOCKDOWN.** The whole campus of Bukidnon National High School (BNHS) where Confirmed Cases Nos. 316, 317, 318, 319 and 320 are employed in Barangay 3, Malaybalay City is hereby placed under localized lockdown and focused containment / community quarantine whereby movement (incoming or outgoing) of all persons within the area is strictly restricted starting midnight of February 2, 2021 to February 16, 2021.

**SECTION 2. ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY.** In implementing the localized lockdown, the Zoning Containment Strategy which is a localized rapid response operation to contain the spread of COVID-19 as a preventive option for intervention shall be adopted as follows:

- a. The lockdown area shall be categorized into the following four (4) zoning classifications:
  - 1) **Critical Zone (CrZ) – Bukidnon National High School Campus in Barangay 3, Malaybalay City**
  - 2) **Containment Zone (CZ) – residences, businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Critical Zone (CrZ)**
  - 3) **Buffer Zone (BZ) – residences, businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Containment Zone (CZ)**
  - 4) **Areas Outside Buffer Zone (OBZ) – residences, businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Buffer Zone (BZ)**
- b. The zoning classifications shall be applied to the following, but not limited to:
  - 1) **Bukidnon National High School Campus – ECQ**
    - Restrictive perimeter control, movement of individuals, regardless of age and health status, within, inbound or outbound is strictly prohibited, except for emergencies such as medical and surgical procedures and/or treatments, as determined by the Malaybalay City IATF
  - 2) **Residences, businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Critical Zone - MECQ**
    - Movement shall be allowed but limited to movement of individuals accessing essential goods and services and those working in permitted offices and establishments
    - Senior citizens, children, individuals with comorbidities and health risks, and other vulnerable groups will be restricted from movement
  - 3) **Residences, businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Containment Zone – GCQ**
    - Movement shall be allowed with observance to minimum health standards
  - 4) **Residences businesses, establishments and government offices within 500-meter radius from the Buffer Zone – MGCQ**
    - Movement shall be allowed with observance to minimum health standards

In order to ensure a seamless integration and effective implementation of the necessary measures, the Coordinated Operations to Defeat Epidemic (CODE) Approach, including case investigation, contact tracing, quarantine, managing of cases, and reintegration activities, along with the intensification of the COVID-19 Disease Surveillance, shall be implemented.

The BIDA (Bawal walang mask, I-sanitize ang kamay at Iwas-hawak sa mga bagay, Dumistansya ng isang metro, at Alamin ang totoong impormasyon) Solusyon and its offshoot BIDA Bastonero as social and behavior change campaign strategies of the Department of Health focusing on COVID-19 preventive behaviors shall be promoted and implemented.
