A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO HEAVY FLOODS BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE TORRENTIAL AND HEAVY RAINS CAUSED BY THE OCCURRENCE OF INTER TROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ)

WHEREAS, the City Mayor in his 1st Endorsement dated June 26, 2023, endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for legislative action CDRRMC Resolution No. 007, Series of 2023, recommending to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Malayblay City to declare and place the City of Malaybalay under a State of Calamity due to heavy flooding;

WHEREAS, as reported by the Rapid Damage and Needs Assessment Analysis (RDANA) Team in this city, the floods affected at least thirteen (13) barangays within the city, causing substantial damage to households, public structures, schools, business establishments, agriculture and livestock products of farmers;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of RA 10121, the declaration and lifting of the state of calamity may also be issued by the local sanggunian, upon the recommendation of the LDRRMC, based on the results of the damage assessment and needs analysis.

WHEREAS, declaring areas to be in a State of Calamity allows the local government to effectively control the pricing of essential needs and allowing both the national and local governments to utilize their funds for rescue, recovery, and rehabilitation measures;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. R M. ORQUIA, duly seconded;

Cont. Res. No. 2023-0409:

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 9th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Malaybalay in a session duly assembled:

RESOLVED, that the City of Malaybalay be declared under a State of Calamity due to heavy floods brought about by torrential and heavy rains caused by the occurrence of an Inter Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) last June 21, 2023;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and other offices concerned for their information and appropriate action;
