

## City Ordinance 962 Article 7; Plastic and Polystyrene Regulation

### Section 14. Regulation on the use of Plastic Bag

- Prohibition on the use of Plastic Bag on dry goods.
- Regulating the use of Plastic bags on wet goods using polystyrene as secondary packaging.
- Regulation on the selling and distribution of plastic bags within the Public Market.
- Individual participation is encouraged to provide for themselves reusable and recyclable shopping bags.
- Exemption - Primary Packaging

### Section 15. Regulations on the use of Polystyrene (STYROFOAM)

- No business establishments, Restaurants, fast food outlets, food kiosks, catering services and the like shall sell or provide styrofoams or expanded polystyrene foam and the like as containers for food and beverages.
- Private and public Institutions shall not utilized or provide Styrofoam and the like as containers for food and beverages during their meetings, events and any activities.
- Exemption: Pre-pack Foods

**Section 16.** Regulations on the use of plastic straws, plastic stirrers, plastic utensils and plastic advertisement and propaganda materials.

**Section 17.** All business establishments are mandated to display conspicuously in their stores the environment friendly notice  
**“ KEEP MALAYBALAY CITY CLEAN AND GREEN,  
 BRING YOUR OWN REUSABLE BAGS”.**

**Section 18.** All business establishments are encourage to adopt the  
**“ BRING YOUR OWN BAG”** Program.  
 Alternative recyclable, reusable and/or biodegradable packaging materials, containers, carry-out bags should be encouraged and promoted.



### Fines and Penalties:

Small business establishments with a capital less than P50,000.00

First offense	P500.00
Second offense	P1,000.00
Third and succeeding offense	P2,000.00 & cancellation of license to operate for business establishment

Big business establishments with a capital more than P50,000.00

First offense	P1000.00
Second offense	P2,000.00
Third and succeeding offense	P5,000.00 & cancellation of license to operate for business establishment

5. **Guinadili** ang pagsulod sa mga prutas o utanon sa **cellophane**.
6. **Magdala** kita ug **eco bag, bayong o reusable bag** kon kita mamalit sa atong panginahanglanon.

First Offense -----P 500.00  
Second Offense -----P 1,000.00  
Third & Succeeding Offense ----P 2,000.00 & Cancellation of business license to operate.

*Big Business establishment with a capital of more than 50,000.00*

First Offense -----P 1,000.00  
Second Offense -----P 2,000.00  
Third & Succeeding Offense ----P 5,000.00 & Cancellation of business license to operate.

---

*For individual offender*

First Offense -----P 500.00 or 1 day community service  
Second Offense -----P 1,000.00 or 3 days community service  
Third & Succeeding Offense ----P 2,000.00 or 7 days community service

**Section 23.** Illegal Dumping and Disposal of Solid Wastes, Debris and other form of solid waste is strictly prohibited within the City of Malaybalay.

**Malaybalay City Ordinance 962 Article 9  
Illegal Dumping and Disposal**

**Section 23.** Illegal Dumping and Disposal. Dumping and Disposal of Solid Waste, Debris, and other form of solid waste is strictly prohibited within the City

**Section 23.1** It shall be unlawful for any person to dispose solid waste, garbage, debris and other waste materials in rivers, creeks, canals, waterways, vacant lots and in any other parts of the City not provided for the purpose.

**Section 23.2** It shall be unlawful for any person to litter or cause littering in any public or private place including schools, parks/playground, roads, canals and waterways.

**Section 23.3** It shall be unlawful for any person to dispose solid wastes or garbage generated from the households, commercial establishments and other sources to garbage receptacles purposely placed/stationed in public areas like the City Plaza, parks, playgrounds

**Section 24** Prohibition on the establishment of garbage pit. Establishment of garbage pit for mixed solid waste by the households, offices, schools, and business establishments is hereby prohibited.

**Section 25** Prohibition on the establishment of disposal areas. Establishment of disposal areas not authorized by law by subdivisions, condominiums, institutions, and industries are hereby prohibited. As such, all subdivisions and condominiums are mandated to establish their own material recovery facility and composting system to cater

**Section 26** Fines and Penalties for violating any provisions of Section 23, 24 and 25 of this Ordinance.

**PENALTY**

**For Violating Section 23.2; 23.3; & 24 of this Ordinance**

First Offense : 500.00 or community service of 1 day (for non-business establishment)

Second Offense 1,000.00 or community service of 3 days

Succeeding Offense : (for non-business establishment) and cancellation of license to operation in the case of business establishments.

*Any violation of Section 23.1 and 25 of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of P3,000.00 and/or imprisonment of 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment upon the discretion of the Court.*
