ORDINANCE ADOPTING AUTOMATIC FARE MATRIX SYSTEM AND PAKYAW FARE MATRIX FOR MOTORELA OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation and Traffic Management found, after several meetings and consultations with motorela drivers and passengers, the difficulty they have been facing due to the fluctuation of gas prices;

WHEREAS, the pandemic and recent events (e.g. war in Ukraine vs. Russia) have severely affected the world market and thus caused fluctuation in fuel prices;

WHEREAS, the committee found a system that would address the fluctuating fuel prices relative to its effect to fare rates including other factors that affects it, such as but not limited to: gas price, net income, number of passengers, etc;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Malaybalay City Franchising and Regulatory Board (MCFRB) relative to the proposed automatic fare matrix system;

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of the discussions during the public hearing the MCFRB resolved to adopt a fair AUTOMATIC FARE MATRIX SYSTEM.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE 9th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Malaybalay City in regular session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This ordinance shall be known as the "**Fare Matrix System of Motorela Operations in the City of Malaybalay.**"

SECTION 2. SCOPE OF APPLICATION – The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to all Motorela's operating within the City of Malaybalay.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

1. Fare Matrix System – a table providing a scale of fare rates based on factors affecting fare adjustments such as gas price and net income of motorela drivers.
2. Motorela – a motor vehicle composed of motorcycle fitted with two-wheeled cab operated as public transport for a fee.

SECTION 4. The automatic "Fare Matrix" System for Motorela drivers within the City of Malaybalay is as follows:

The Fare Matrix System had been derived from computing the average number of passengers, fare, gasoline consumption, trips, maximum daily rounds less expenses (e.g. gasoline expenses, motorela rental) etc.

$$\text{Fare: } \frac{(\text{net income} + \text{rental}) + (\text{gas consumption} \times \text{price per liter})}{(\text{no. of passenger}) \times (\text{no. of trips})}$$

The computation is based on the maximum eight (8) passengers per trip. It also provides 20% discount to Senior Citizens, PWD (Person with Disability), and Students.

SECTION 5. FARE MATRIX FOR PAKYAW SYSTEM. A new pakyaw fare system is adopted and shall be computed as follows:

FARE COMPUTATION

<p>Within Poblacion Area</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FARE: $\text{(Average passenger capacity per Motorela)} \times \text{(current fare only)}^*$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">e.g. $6 \text{ passengers} \times \text{P}10.00 = \text{P}60.00$</p> <p style="font-size: small;">* Since the poblacion is more densely populated at any given time.</p>

THE PAKYAW FARE MATRIX SYSTEM TABLE

The pakyaw rate shall only be imposed from 8:00 pm at the Terminal area and 9:00 pm within the Poblacion **ONLY**, with a one (1) hour leeway for students who just got out of school.

Senior citizens, students, and PWDs should still be granted their lawful 20% discount in relation to the Pakyaw Fare Matrix System.

SECTION 6. MONITORING AND APPREHENSION PROVISIONS. Upon implementation of the ordinance the following agencies shall coordinate to monitor and apprehend possible violators of the fare matrix system, to wit: Traffic Management Center (TMC), City Business Permits and Licensing Office, Philippine National Police (PNP) and Land Transportation Office (LTO).

Cont. Ord. No. 1023, Series of 2023:

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The City Mayor's Office, the City Business Permits and Licensing Office and the City Legal Office shall provide the details through an Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), if and when necessary.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, memorandum circulars and all other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. The provision of this ordinance is separable and in any event that any provision herein are declared invalid, the validity of all other provisions shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication in a newspaper of local circulation and after posting in three (3) conspicuous places.
