AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CASH PAYMENT SYSTEM FOR THE ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION (AI) SERVICE RENDERED BY THE MALAYBALAY CITY BREEDING CENTER, PHILIPPINES, AND PROVIDING ADVANTAGES FOR FARMERS AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF MALAYBALAY CITY

WHEREAS, the Malaybalay City Breeding Center provides artificial insemination services for swine to support the local farming community;

WHEREAS, the existing practice of collecting one piglet as payment for the artificial insemination service poses certain limitations and challenges such as but not limited to, false claims of inconceivability of the pig or intentionally concealing the newly born piglets to avoid the payment of one piglet;

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to introduce a cash payment system to provide farmers with flexibility, economic benefits, and reduced risk, while enabling the local government to enhance revenue generation, administrative efficiency and resource allocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the 9th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Malaybalay City, Philippines, in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title. This city ordinance shall be known as the “**Cash Payment for the Artificial Insemination for Swine Service Rendered.**”

Section 2. Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this City ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- a. Artificial insemination (AI) - a method of treating infertility by inserting semen directly into a womb.

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- b. **Payment System** – refers the set of payment instruments, processes, procedures and participants that ensures the circulation of money or movement of funds.

Section 3. Scope. This ordinance shall cover the AI swine services rendered by the City Veterinarian Office in the City of Malaybalay.

Section 4. Revenue Generation: The Malaybalay City Breeding Center shall implement a cash payment system for the artificial insemination service provided to farmers for swine breeding purposes. The local government shall directly collect fees in the amount of P500.00 (Five hundred pesos only) for the AI service, ensuring a consistent and sustainable income source for the Malaybalay City Breeding Center, as authorized by the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160.

- a. **Administrative Efficiency:** The introduction of a cash payment system simplifies administrative processes, reduces paperwork and facilitates efficient financial management within the breeding center, in accordance with the applicable provisions of Republic Act No. 9485, also known as Anti-Red Tape Act of 2007.
- b. **Resource Allocation Optimization:** Cash payments enable the local government to allocate resources strategically towards enhancing the breeding center's operations, including the procurement of supplies, equipment, and staff remuneration, as well as supporting agricultural development initiatives within Malaybalay City, in compliance with the relevant provisions of Republic Act No. 7160.

Section 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations.

The Malaybalay City Breeding Center in coordination with the City Treasurer's Office shall develop guidelines and procedures to ensure the effective implementation of the cash payment system, subject to approval by the local government authorities, in accordance with the requirements set forth in Republic Act No. 7160 and Republic Act 9485.

The local government shall provide necessary support, including public awareness campaigns and farmer education initiatives, to facilitate the transition to the cash payment system, as mandated by Republic Act No. 7160 and Republic Act 9485.

- a. Clients may request Artificial Insemination Service either by walking in or via an on-call service.
- b. Clients shall pay a fee of Five Hundred (500) Pesos to the assigned officer of the day.
- c. The assigned officer of the day will issue a receipt upon payment. If the client requests an on-call service, the responding technician will issue a ticket payment slip as proof of payment.
- d. The artificial insemination of the animal will proceed.
- e. The following day, the AI technician will conduct a follow-up artificial insemination on the previously inseminated animal, and no additional payment is required.
- f. If, between 18-21 days after insemination, the animal exhibits signs of "estrus" or "in-heat", it will be considered a failure of conception, marking the end of the coverage of the Five Hundred Pesos fee previously paid by the client. Further Artificial Insemination of the same animal will require another fee of Five Hundred (500) Pesos.
- g. In cases of successful conception, services such as Iron supplementation on the 3rd and 14th days, castration, vitamin supplementation, treatment, and consultation shall be provided free of charge to those clients who are residents of the City of Malaybalay.
- h. For clients whose animals are located outside the city, semen shall be sold at Five Hundred (500) Pesos per bottle.
- i. The boar semen supply produced by the City Veterinary Office- Swine Breeding Center is also available to interested individuals, LGU's, backyard and commercial farms outside Malaybalay City, and it shall be sold at Five Hundred (500) Pesos per bottle.

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- j. All payments collected shall be deposited into the Trust fund development program of the Malaybalay City Livestock Production Breeding and Training Center.
- k. Creation and guidelines of the Malaybalay City Livestock Production Breeding and Training Center Development Trust fund.

1. All payments will be deposited to the development TRUSTFUND of the Malaybalay City Livestock Production Breeding and Training Center along with proper reports.
2. Scope for budgeted allocation:
 - a. Facility Maintenance and Upkeep:
Including but not limited to repairs and maintenance of facilities, fencing, and security systems, as well as waste management systems.
 - b. Staffing and Training:
Incorporating training programs for staff pertaining to breeding techniques and animal care.
 - c. Feed and Nutrition:
Allotment for the procurement of high-quality feed for Breeding Stocks, aimed at the preservation of their health and fertility.
 - d. Veterinary Care and Health Programs:
Encompassing regular health check-ups and vaccinations for Breeding Stocks, alongside provisions for emergency veterinary care and medications.
 - e. Breeding Program Management:
Inclusive of genetic testing and selection processes for breeding, record keeping, and data management systems, as well as provisions for the replenishment and replacement of breeding stocks.
 - f. Reproduction and Artificial Insemination Equipment:
Allocation for the procurement of semen collection and processing equipment, as well as artificial insemination tools and supplies.
 - g. Utilities:
Provision for alternative systems for water and electricity supply to the facility.
 - h. Transportation:
Including maintenance intervals for the transportation of animals and semen.
 - i. Quality Control and Testing:
Allocation for lab equipment to evaluate semen quality, along with the implementation of quality control measures for processed semen
3. Guidelines for the withdrawal of funds for utilization and any other transaction subject to certain conditions that disbursements shall be subject to the specific guidelines, laws, rules and regulations, issuances, auditing rules, and regulations and provisions in accordance with the IRR of R.A. 7160.
4. All of the contents of said trust fund shall automatically be reverted back to the City General Fund in case of the dissolution of the purpose of this said ordinance.

Cont. Ord. No. 1030, Series of 2023:

Section 6. Separability Clause. Should any of the provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other remaining portions not so declared shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 7. Repealing Clause. Any Ordinance, Resolution, or Order, or part or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby amended, repealed, or modified accordingly.

Section 8. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation within the city or posting in three (3) conspicuous places.
